

Amendments to the Criteria for the Gold Medal

1. Chancellor's Gold Medal:

The valedictorian from the undergraduate program and the student from the Masters Programs obtaining the highest CGPA shall be awarded the Chancellor's Gold Medal. However, obtaining a **minimum CGPA of 3.8** is mandatory for being a recipient of Chancellor's Gold Medal.

2. Vice Chancellor's Gold Medal:

The student obtaining the highest CGPA in each of the undergraduate and graduate programs from every department shall receive the Vice Chancellor's Gold Medal provided he/she obtains a **CGPA of minimum 3.65**.

In case of a recipient of the Chancellor's Gold Medal from a particular department /program the student obtaining the second highest CGPA shall receive the Vice Chancellor's Gold Medal.

In case of a tie, the CGPA average will be calculated to three or more decimal places and the higher CGPA will be considered for the medal.

Other Rules/conditions:

- Must not have a record of dropping course(s) (no more than two) after a time period for add/drop
- No F, I, W & No Retake or Repeat
- Shall not have any record of disciplinary action(s)
- Minimum credit earned at BRACU must be $\geq 80\%$ of the courses required for degree completion at BRAC University
- Must take minimum 9 credits each semester in undergraduate programs and minimum 6 credits each semester in postgraduate program
- Has actively participated in at least one club/extra-curricular/co-curricular activity in one semester per year
